Scope	<p>From this drop-down list, select the desired scope. The default scopes are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Non-Project Files■ Problems■ All■ Production■ Tests <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"><p>To use custom scopes, click the Manage Scopes button in the File Colors dialog box and define the desired scopes in the Scopes dialog box, that opens.</p></div>
Color	<p>In this area, select the desired color label to use as the background for displaying the names of files, folders, or packages within the specified scope.</p>
