Item	Description
Visibility	From this drop-down list, select the desired visibility modifier.
Type	Specify the type of the new field. Note that <a href="#">code completion</a> works here. As you type, the suggestion list shrinks to show the matching options. Non-existent type is marked as a syntax error.
Name	Specify the name of the new field.
Initializer	<p>Specify the initial value of the new field. Note that such value should correspond to the declared type. For example, if the type is <i>String</i>, the suggested initializer should be enclosed in quotes.</p> <p>Note that <a href="#">code completion</a> works here. As you type, the suggestion list shrinks to show the matching options. Non-existent type is marked as a syntax error.</p>
Static	Select this check box to add <code>final</code> to the field declaration.
Final	Select this check box to add <code>static</code> to the field declaration.
Preview	This read-only area shows the draft declaration as you fill in the dialog fields.
