

Adding a Struts Facet to a Module

When you add the Struts [facet](#) to an existing module, IntelliJ IDEA downloads and adds the necessary libraries automatically.

A Struts 2 facet can be created only as a child of a Web facet. If the module has no Web facet, create it first.

This will change the [configuration of the module](#).

To add the dedicated struts facet to an existing module

1. Open the [Module Settings](#) dialog box.
2. In the **Modules** node, right-click the relevant module.
3. To add a Web facet, choose **New** from the context menu. In the drop-down list of available facets, select **Web**.
4. Right-click the **Web** node and select **New** on its context menu.
5. Select **Struts** on the context menu of available facets. The right-hand pane displays the [Facet 'Struts'](#) dialog.
6. [Customize the default Struts facet settings](#) in the [Struts Features](#) and [Validation](#) tabs.
7. If some additional libraries are required, the corresponding warning message displays. Click **Fix**. The necessary libraries will be downloaded and added automatically.
