

Associating a Project Root with Version Control System

IntelliJ IDEA suggests a command that allows one-click enabling of version control integration. So doing, the selected VCS becomes associated with the project root. To learn how to associate the other content roots with the different version control systems, refer to the section [Associating a Directory with a Specific Version Control System](#).

To assign a version control system to a project root

1. Choose **VCS | Enable Version Control Integration**, or press **Alt+Back Quote**, and choose **Enable Version Control Integration**. The [Enable Version Control Integration](#) dialog box opens.
2. In the **Please select version control system to make your <Project Root> under** drop-down list, select the version control system that you want to assign to your [project root](#).
