

Building Method Hierarchy

A method hierarchy makes it possible to examine a tree-view of the classes where a given method is:

- defined (+).
- not defined, but defined in the superclass (-).
- to be defined, because the class is not abstract (!).

To build a method hierarchy

1. Select the desired method in the Project tool window, or place the caret at the method declaration in the editor.
2. Do one of the following:
 - On the main menu, choose **Navigate | Method Hierarchy**.
 - Press **Ctrl+Shift+H**.
