

CDI Tool Window

View | Tool Windows | CDI

The **CDI** tool window provides a categorized hierarchical view of your CDI resources (beans).





At the top of the hierarchy are your modules. One level below are categories.

The categories correspond to bean types and qualifiers. You can show or hide the categories using the toolbar buttons. You can also open the elements shown in the tool window in the editor.

Toolbar

Use the toolbar buttons to show or hide the corresponding `show_hide_what`. All the buttons are toggles that enable or disable displaying a category.

Item	Tooltip	Description
	@Named	Click this button to show or hide @Named beans (the elements annotated with @Named).
	Custom Qualifiers	Click this button to show or hide the elements annotated with custom annotations.
	Scope Types	Click this button to show or hide scope types (the elements annotated with @ApplicationScoped, @SessionScoped, @RequestScoped, etc.).
	Deployment Types	Click this button to show or hide deployment types.

Opening elements in the editor

You can open the elements shown in the **CDI** tool window in the editor. To do that, select the element of interest and press F4.

To open the elements which are the "leaves" of the tree (i. e. the ones at the bottom of the hierarchy), you can also use a double click.
