The dialog box opens when you click the **Add** button and choose **Composer** in the **Choose Tool to Add** dialog box.

Use the dialog box to enable the use of [Composer Dependency Manager](#) in the command line mode.

Integration with *Composer* is provided at the IntelliJ IDEA level, so once configured, the tool can be used in all your IntelliJ IDEA projects. Just activate or de-activate it when necessary depending on you needs.

| Item | Description |
|-----------------------|---|
| Path to composer.phar | In this text box, specify the location of the <code>composer.phar</code> archive. Type the path manually or click the Browse button  and choose the desired location in the dialog box that opens. IntelliJ IDEA parses the contents of the specified file for Composer commands. |
