


Configuring Browsers

To have the preview of your application output displayed in the browser, you need to tell IntelliJ IDEA which browser you want to be used by default. This browser is called *IntelliJ IDEA default browser*.

To enable use of browsers

1. Open the [Web Browsers](#) page of the [Settings](#) dialog box.
2. Specify the browser to use by default.
 - To accept the default operating system browser as default for IntelliJ IDEA, select the **Use system default browser** check box.
 - To have another browser used as default, select the **Use** option and specify the location of the executable file of the required browser. Type the path manually or use the **Browse** button , if necessary.

IntelliJ IDEA calls the default browser to render external resources as well.

3. Specify the way to have the browser launched.
 - To enable using a browser from the context menu, select the **Active** check box in the relevant section.
 - To have IntelliJ IDEA launch a browser using the default system command, select the **Default** check box in the relevant section.
 - To have IntelliJ IDEA launch a browser using the executable file, specify the path to it.
