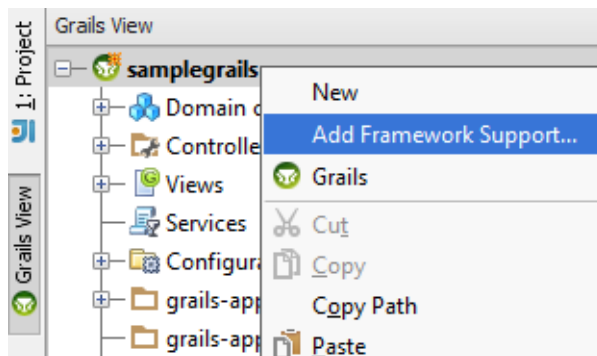


Configuring Groovy-Based Frameworks

If you want to extend an existing module with *Groovy* or *Groovy-based frameworks* support, use the **Add Framework Support** command available on the context menu of a module in the [Project](#), [Grails](#) or [Griffon](#) tool windows.



When a certain technology is enabled in a module, the corresponding SDK is added to the module classpath.

If you already have a Groovy library specified in the module then the Groovy-based frameworks are not displayed in the **Add Framework Support** list.

To add frameworks support to a module, do one of the following

- In the **Project** tool window, right-click the desired module node, and choose **Add Framework Support** from the context menu. Then, in the [Add Frameworks Support dialog](#), select the check boxes for the technologies you want to be enabled in your module, and specify the associated settings.
- [Open the module settings](#) and click **+**. Choose the desired facet from the list. Configure the facet settings as required.
