Assembly Descriptor References - EJB Local References References pane

The dialog box opens when you click the **Add** button  and select **EJB Local Reference** in the context menu.

Use this dialog box to specify the properties of the `<ejb-local-ref>` element.

Item	Property generated in web.xml	Description
Name	<code><ejb-ref-name></code>	In this field, specify the EJB reference name relative to <code>java:comp/env</code> context.
Type	<code><ejb-ref-type></code>	Use this drop-down list to select the expected type of the referenced EJB. The available options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Entity■ Session
Home Interface	<code><local-home></code>	In this field, specify the fully-qualified name of the EJB's local home interface.
		Click this button to open the Choose Class dialog box.
Remote Interface	<code><local></code>	In this field, specify the class that implements the referenced EJB component.
		Click this button to open the Choose Class dialog box.
Link	<code><ejb-link></code>	Specifies that the EJB reference is linked to an EJB. The link is composed as follows: <code><The path to the ejb-jar containing the referenced EJB>#<the ejb-name of the target bean></code> The path name is relative to the WAR file containing the Web application.
Description	<code><description></code>	In this field, provide a description of the reference.
		Click this button to open the Text dialog box for entering the textual description.
