The dialog box opens when you click the **Add** button  and select **EJB Resource Environment Reference** in the context menu.

Use this dialog box to specify the properties of the `<resource-env-ref>` element.

Item	Property generated in web.xml	Description
Name	<code>&lt;resource-env-ref-name&gt;</code>	In this field, specify the name of the resource environment reference. The name must contain the EJB reference name used in the code of the Web application.
Type	<code>&lt;resource-env-ref-type&gt;</code>	In this field, specify the fully qualified name of the Java language class or interface that implements the type of the resource environment reference.
		Click this button to open the <b>Choose Class</b> dialog box.
Description	<code>&lt;description&gt;</code>	In this field, provide a description of the reference.
