Item	Property generated in web.xml	Description
Name	<code><env-entry-name></code>	Specify the name of the environment entry.
Value	<code><env-entry-value></code>	Specify the value of the environment entry.
Type	<code><env-entry-type></code>	Use this drop-down list to select the Java type of the environment entry.
Description	<code><description></code>	Provide a description of the environment entry.
	Click this button to open the Text dialog box for entering a textual description.
