

Creating a Gradle-Android Project

You can create a Gradle-Android project or add a new Gradle-Android module to an existing project.

To create a Gradle-based Android project

1. Do one of the following:
 - If you are going to create a new project: click **Create New Project** on the [Welcome screen](#) or select **File | New Project**.
As a result, the [New Project wizard](#) opens.
 - If you are going to add a module to an existing project: [open the project](#) you want to add a module to, and select **File | New Module**.
As a result, the [New Module wizard](#) opens.
2. On the first page of the wizard, in the left-hand pane, select **Android**. In the right-hand part of the page, select **Gradle: Android Module**. Click **Next**.
3. Specify the JDK and Android SDK to be used, and click **Next**.
4. Specify your [Android module settings](#), and click **Next**.
5. Specify the settings for your [Android-Gradle Foreground](#) configuration, and click **Next**.
6. Select an [Android application template](#) from the list, and click **Next**.
7. Specify the [settings](#) for the selected Android Activity template, and click **Next**.
8. Specify the name and location settings. For more information, see [Project Name and Location](#) or [Module Name and Location](#).
Click **Finish**.
