

Creating a Project from Scratch

1. If no project is currently open in IntelliJ IDEA, click **Create New Project** on the [Welcome screen](#). Otherwise, select **New Project** from the **File** menu.

As a result, the [New Project wizard](#) opens.

2. On the [first page of the wizard](#), in the left-hand pane, select the project category. This may be the technology that you are going to use, the platform or runtime that your development is going to target, etc.
