

Defining the Filter Element


The **Filter** element defines the name of the filter and specifies the compiled class that implements it.

IntelliJ IDEA provides the facilities to configure, edit, and remove **Filter** elements using the [Web Module Editor](#) window, **General** tab. The tab is synchronized with the **Text** tab where the code is generated based on the settings you specify.

To define a filter

1. Configure a [new filter](#).
2. Click **OK** in the [New Filter](#) dialog box. The new filter is added to the list in the **Filters Configured** pane.

To edit a filter

1. Select the required filter from the list in the **Filters Configured** pane and click . The **Edit Filter** dialog box opens.
2. Proceed as during the [filter configuration](#).
