

Defining the Servlet Mapping Element

The **Servlet Mapping** element defines the URL pattern that associates the servlet with the set of URLs that call the servlet.

To define the mapping of a servlet

1. Select the servlet in the **Servlets Configured** pane, tab [General](#), and switch to the [Assembly Descriptor](#) tab.
2. In the [Servlet Mappings](#) pane, click **+**. A new row appears with the **Servlet** text box displaying the name of the selected servlet.
3. In the **URL Pattern** text box, specify the URL pattern to associate the servlet with the URLs that call the servlet.

A URL pattern may contain a subset of US-ASCII characters. Avoid using other values.

To remove a mapping

- Select the relevant row and click **-**.
