Ctrl+Q or Alt+Button2 Click

This tool window appears in the following cases:

- [Quick Documentation lookup](#) is pinned by clicking  in the upper-right side of the lookup window.
- [Quick Definition tooltip](#) is pinned by clicking  in the upper-right corner of the tooltip.

As a result, the tool window appears in the list of available tool windows in the **View** menu, and gets the corresponding sidebar icon  Documentation .

Icon	Keyboard shortcut	Action
	Shift+Alt+Left or Shift+Alt+Right	Navigate to the previous or next screen after using hyperlinks in the definition. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;">On a OS X computer, you can also use the three-finger right-to-left and left-to-right swipe gestures.</div>
	Shift+F1	View external documentation in the default browser.
		When this button is pressed, the Documentation tool window automatically opens for an element at caret.
		Click this button to close the tool window. After the next use of Ctrl+Q or Alt+Button2 Click, the documentation will be shown in the popup again.
		Click this button to show font size slider. Move the slider to increase or decrease the font size as required.
