Enable Drupal integration	Select this check box to have the functionality applied to your sources.
Drupal installation path	In this text box, specify the root folder of the <i>Drupal</i> installation. Type the path manually or click the <b>Browse</b> button  and select the relevant folder in the dialog box that opens.
Set up PHP   Include paths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Select this check box to have <i>Drupal include paths</i> automatically configured for the project. The following paths will be added to the <b>Include Paths</b> list on the <a href="#">PHP</a> page of the <b>Settings</b> dialog box:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. &lt;drupal installation root&gt;/includes</li><li>2. &lt;drupal installation root&gt;/modules</li><li>3. &lt;drupal installation root&gt;/sites/all/modules</li></ol><div data-bbox="488 952 1396 1081" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin: 10px 0;"><p>The <i>include paths</i> are added to the list after you leave the dialog box.</p></div></li><li>■ Clear the check box to configure the <i>include paths</i> manually.</li></ul>
