The dialog box opens when you click the **Add** button and choose **Drush** in the **Choose Tool to Add** dialog box. Use the dialog box to configure *Drush* support in IntelliJ IDEA.

*Drush* is a command line shell and scripting interface for [Drupal](#). With IntelliJ IDEA, you can use *Drush 5.8* and higher. For more details, see [Using Drupal with IntelliJ IDEA](#) and [Drupal-Specific Coding Assistance](#).

Item	Description
Path to Drush	In this text box, specify the path to the <i>Drush</i> executable file. IntelliJ IDEA automatically fills in the default location, which is usually <code>C:/ProgramData/Drush/drush.bat</code> on Windows and <code>/usr/bin/drush</code> on Mac OS or Linux. If you followed the standard installation procedure, the predefined path will be correct, just click <b>OK</b> , whereupon IntelliJ IDEA loads command definitions automatically and returns to the <b>Command Line Tool Support</b> page.
