





Editing Maven Settings

A project is imported or created according the default Maven integration settings. Further, you can configure the current project in the [Maven Integration](#) dialog invoked by the  button. These settings are used on project reopening and synchronizing.

Besides settings that apply to the current project, IntelliJ IDEA provides the possibility to configure the default settings, which apply to all newly created or imported projects. These settings are available in the [Maven Integration: Default settings](#) dialog, invoked by the  button, or in the [Template Project settings](#).

To configure the maven integration settings

1. On the toolbar of the Maven Projects tool window, click  button for the current project, or  button for the default settings.
2. In the [Maven](#) page of the Settings dialog, specify the desired options. Refer to the dialog description for details.
3. Apply changes and close the dialog.
