


Editing the Servlet Element

To edit a servlet

1. Select the servlet in the **Servlets Configured** pane, tab **General**, and click  or select **Edit** in the context menu. The **Servlet Initialization Params** pane opens.
2. To specify another class to implement the servlet, click **Change Class**. The **Choose Servlet Class** dialog box opens.
3. Select the name of the relevant class and click **OK**.

To search among the classes outside the current project, select the **Include non-project classes** check box.

4. To rename the servlet, click **Rename Servlet**. The **Rename Servlet** dialog box opens.
5. In the **Servlet Name** text box, edit the root path of the servlet name.
6. To automatically update the corresponding source code, click **Refactor**.
7. To preview the refactoring results, click **Preview**. The **Refactoring Preview** window opens.

The window is synchronized with the `web.xml` file in the **Text** tab.

8. View the suggested refactoring. To accept the suggestions, click **Do Refactor**.
9. Proceed with [specifying the initialization attributes of the servlet](#).
