


EJB Local References

Web Tool Window | Context Menu of a Web module | Jump To Source | Assembly Descriptor References

In this pane, define the `<ejb-local-ref>` element that declares a reference to the local home of an EJB.

Based on the settings you specify in this pane, IntelliJ IDEA generates the properties of the `<ejb-local-ref>` element in the `web.xml` descriptor.

Item	Property generated in <code>web.xml</code>	Description
EJB Local References	<code><ejb-ref-name></code>	In this field, specify the name of the EJB local reference relative to <code>java:comp/env</code> context. The name must contain the EJB reference name used in the code of the Web application.
		Click this button to open the Edit EJB Local Reference dialog box. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;">The button is available only in a selected row.</div>
Type	<code><ejb-ref-type></code>	Use this drop-down list to select the expected type of the referenced EJB. The available options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Entity■ Session
Description	<code><description></code>	Provide a description of the reference.
Home	<code><local-home></code>	In this field, specify the fully-qualified name of the EJB's local home interface.
Component	<code><local></code>	In this field, specify the class that implements the referenced EJB component.
Link	<code><ejb-link></code>	In this field, specify the link from the EJB reference to the referenced EJB.
