

In this page, enable IntelliJ IDEA to use Emmet in HTML, XML files and style sheets.

Item	Description
Expand abbreviation with	<p>Use this drop-down box to select the default key to expand Emmet selectors with.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"><p>This key will also by default expand Zen Coding live templates. You can re-define this default setting for each specific live template.</p></div>
XML	
Enable XML Emmet	Select this check box to enable Emmet (aka Zen Coding) support for XML. If this check box is not selected, the complicated abbreviations, like <code>div.class>ul#list>.item\$</code>), will not work in the editor.
Enable BEM filter by default	Select this check box to make use of the BEM filters .
Enable abbreviation preview	<p>If this check box is selected, IntelliJ IDEA shows a pop-up window with the preview of the entered abbreviation, prior to actually expanding it.</p> 
CSS	
Enable CSS Emmet	Select this check box to enable Emmet (aka Zen Coding) support for the style sheets. If this check box is not selected, the complicated abbreviations, like <code>bdci:n</code> expanding into <code>border-corner-image: none;</code> , will not work in the editor.
Enable fuzzy search among CSS abbreviations	<p>Select this check box to enable fuzzy search among CSS snippet names. When enabled, every unknown abbreviation will be scored against available template names. The match with best score will be used to resolve template. For example, with this option enabled, the following abbreviations can be equal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ <code>ov:h</code>■ <code>ov-h</code>■ <code>o-h</code>■ <code>oh</code>

Item	Description									
Enable expansion of unknown properties ('unknown' to 'unknown:;')	If this check box is selected, then any entered word will expand into the same word appended by a colon and semicolon; If this check box is not selected, then only known properties (for example, color) will be expanded this way (color:;)									
Auto insert CSS vendor prefixes	If this check box is selected, the CSS properties listed in the table below are expanded into constructs that contain pre-pending vendor prefixes. If this check box is not selected, the entire properties table is disabled.									
Properties and vendor prefixes	This table contains the list of CSS properties and vendor prefixes for the various browsers. Select or clear the check boxes under each browser column to enable or disable prefixes for certain browsers. <table border="1" data-bbox="419 763 1396 1012" style="margin-top: 10px;"> <thead> <tr> <th></th> <th></th> <th></th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">+</td> <td>Alt+Insert</td> <td>Click this button to add a new property with the specified name to the list.</td> </tr> <tr> <td style="text-align: center;">-</td> <td>Alt+Delete</td> <td>Click this button to remove one or more selected properties from the list.</td> </tr> </tbody> </table>				+	Alt+Insert	Click this button to add a new property with the specified name to the list.	-	Alt+Delete	Click this button to remove one or more selected properties from the list.
