Tools | Web Services | Enable Web Service Support

In this dialog box, enable support of a particular implementation to develop the server or the client side of a Web service. The dialog box allows for more flexible configuring of Web service development support by choosing a specific platform version to be used. You can also specify whether you need to have a sample class created or not.

Choose Module	<p>From this drop-down list, select the module to enable Web service or Web service client development in.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"><p>The drop-down list contains only modules with Web development support enabled.</p></div>
Type	<p>From this drop-down list, select the Web service side to enable support of. The available options are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Server■ Client
Web Service Platform	<p>From this drop-down list, select the Web service platform to use in development.</p>
Add Sample Code	<p>Select this check box to have a sample class generated.</p>
Status	<p>View the information in this read-only field to track and improve discrepancies when configuring the code generation procedure.</p>
