

Enabling Struts Support

Enabling the [Struts framework support](#) for developing Web applications in IntelliJ IDEA involves:

- [Configuring the module, downloading and adding the required libraries](#). Use the dedicated Web and Struts [facets](#) to have it done automatically.
- [Enabling support of additional Struts features](#) by customizing the Struts facet.

To configure a struts module and download the required libraries

Do one of the following:

- [Create a new module](#) with the dedicated Web and Struts facets. IntelliJ IDEA will download and add the necessary libraries and configure the project automatically.
- [Add the dedicated Web and Struts facets to an existing module](#).

A Struts facet can be created only as a child of a Web facet so you need to create a Web facet first.
