In this pane, define the `<env-entry>` element that declares an environment entry for a Web application.

Based on the settings you specify in this pane, IntelliJ IDEA generates the properties of the `<env-entry>` element in the `web.xml` descriptor.

Item	Property generated in <code>web.xml</code>	Description
Environment Entries	<code><env-entry-name></code>	Specify the name of the environment entry.
		Click this button to open the Edit Environment Entry dialog box. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;">The button is available only in a selected row.</div>
Type	<code><env-entry-type></code>	Use this drop-down list to select the Java type of the environment entry.
Description	<code><description></code>	Provide a description of the environment entry.
		Click this button to open the Description dialog box for entering a description. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;">The button is available only when the Description field is selected.</div>
Value	<code><env-entry-value></code>	Specify the value of the environment entry.
