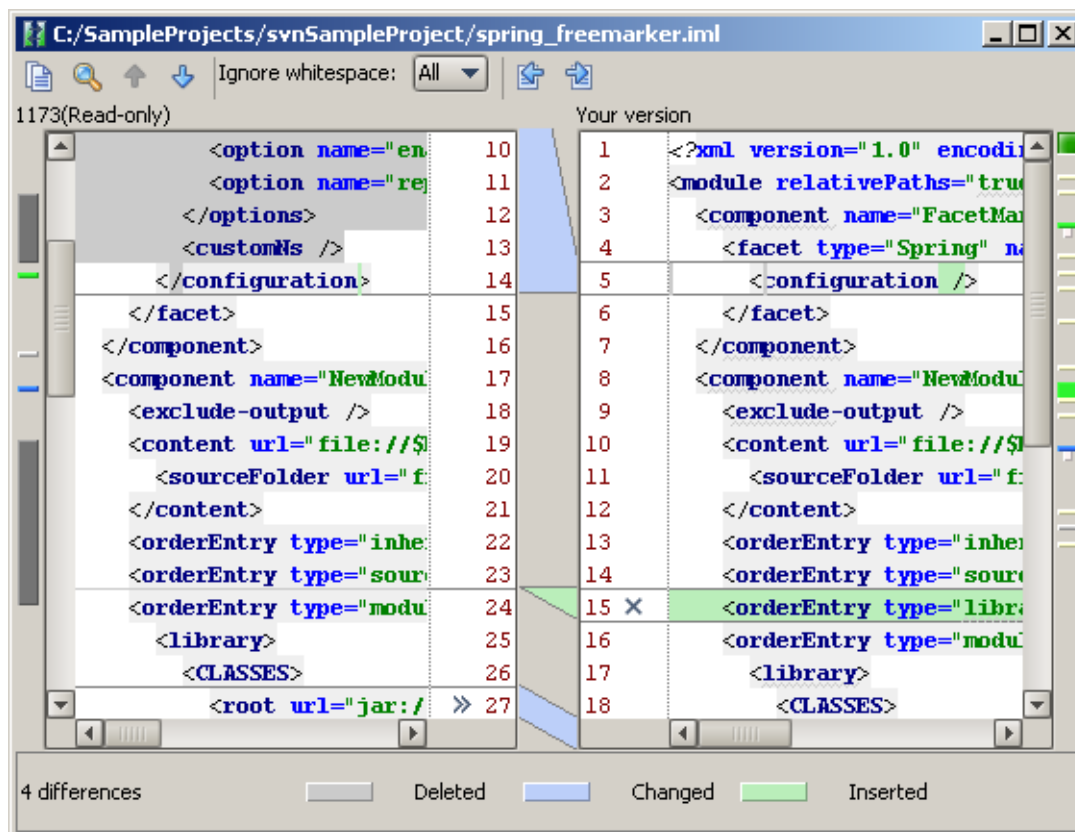


Handling Differences

IntelliJ IDEA enables you to examine the differences between two revisions of a file, or between the current local copy and any repository version. Differences display in the [Differences viewer](#). This window enables you to compare files and versions, navigate and search through the changes, copy and edit source code. Use the legend of the viewer to recognize modified, deleted and added lines of code.
