

# Libraries and Global Libraries

File | Project Structure | Global Libraries



When you select the **Libraries** or the **Global Libraries** category in the **Project Structure dialog**, a list of existing project or global libraries is shown in the **element selector pane**.

Use the toolbar icons, context menu commands or keyboard shortcuts to manage the libraries (see below).

To view or edit the name and contents of a library, select the library of interest, and use the **page to the right** of the selector pane.

## Toolbar icons, context menu commands and shortcuts

Icon	Command	Shortcut	Description
	New Project Library or New Global Library	Alt+Insert	Use this icon, command or shortcut to create a new project or global library. See <a href="#">Creating a project or a global library</a> .
	Delete	Delete	Use this icon, command or shortcut to delete the selected library.
	Copy		Use this icon or command to create a copy of the selected library. See <a href="#">Creating a copy of a project or global library</a> .
	Find Usages	Alt+F7	Use this icon, command or shortcut to find the usages of the selected library in the project.
	Move to Global Libraries		For a project library: use this command to move the selected project library to the global (IDE) level. See <a href="#">Moving a project library to a global level</a> .
	Copy to Project Libraries		For a global library: use this command to create a copy of the selected global library at the project level. See <a href="#">Creating a copy of a global library at the project level</a> .
	Add to Modules		Use this command to add the selected project or global library to <b>dependencies</b> of one or more of your <b>modules</b> . In the dialog that opens, select the corresponding modules.
