

Library Bundling



Use this page to define rules that determine the libraries to be included in bundles and have manifest file entries generated based on these rules.

Item	Description															
Rules	<p>In this area, configure a list of regular expressions that define the libraries to be included in a bundle.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin: 5px 0;"><p>The rules are processed from top to bottom. If a library matches several regular expressions, the one that comes last is applied. Therefore it is recommended that you have the list sorted as follows: the more strict a rule the closer it is to the bottom. For example, it is recommended to put the pattern <code>*.*</code> at the top of the list and an exact match in the bottom.</p></div> <table border="1" style="width: 100%; border-collapse: collapse;"><thead><tr><th>Item</th><th>Command</th><th>Description</th></tr></thead><tbody><tr><td style="text-align: center;"></td><td>Add</td><td>Click this button to have a new entry added to the list.</td></tr><tr><td style="text-align: center;"></td><td>Remove</td><td>Click this button to remove the selected entry from the list.</td></tr><tr><td style="text-align: center;"></td><td>Copy</td><td>Click this button to create a copy of the selected rule.</td></tr><tr><td style="text-align: center;"></td><td>Move Up and Move Down</td><td>Use these buttons to change the order of rules in the list.</td></tr></tbody></table>	Item	Command	Description		Add	Click this button to have a new entry added to the list. Library name pattern	<p>In this text box, specify the regular expression that constitutes the entry selected in the Rules list box.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin: 5px 0;"><p>When a new rule is added to the list, the text box by default shows <code>*.*</code>.</p></div>															
Manifest entries	<p>This read-only field displays the manifest file entries generated on the basis of specified rules. The entries are sorted in accordance with the order of rules in the Rules list box.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin: 5px 0;"><p>The Add New line quick fix is available.</p></div>															
Never bundle	<p>If this check box is selected, the libraries that match the currently selected rule are never bundled.</p>															
Process no further rules	<p>Select this check box to suppress processing rules that come in the Rules list box after the selected rule.</p>
