

# Managing Branches

---

IntelliJ IDEA supports processing of multiple Git branches using sophisticated checkout and merge strategies and provides interface for configuring operations on branches.

For dealing with branches, use **Branches** node and the nested commands. This node is available on:

- Main **VCS** menu
- Context menu of the editor
- VCS operations pop-up.
