Use this page to define the properties of a new Maven module.

Item	Description
Add as module to	<p>Specify the aggregator Maven project.</p> <p>If you want the new module to be aggregated in an existing Maven project, click the ellipsis button, and select the desired aggregator. The new Maven Module will be added to the <code><modules></code> section of the <code>pom.xml</code> file of the aggregator, for example:</p> <pre><modules> <module>mod1</module> <module>mod2</module> </modules></pre> <p><code>none</code> means that the new module will not be aggregated into an existing Maven project.</p>
Parent	<p>Click the ellipsis button and select the desired parent Maven project from the list of existing ones.</p> <p>If a new module has a parent, the following section is added to its <code>pom.xml</code> file, for example:</p> <pre><parent> <groupId>org.something</groupId> <artifactId>parent1</artifactId> <version>0.1</version> </parent></pre> <p><code>none</code> means that the new module doesn't have a parent and thus doesn't inherit properties and profiles of any Maven project.</p>
GroupId	<p>Specify <code>GroupId</code> of the new module, which will be added to the <code>pom.xml</code> file of the module. By default, <code>GroupId</code> equals the module name. If a parent Maven project is specified, this coordinate can be inherited from the parent. To do that, select the Inherit check box.</p>
ArtifactId	<p>Specify <code>ArtifactId</code> of the new module, which will be added to the <code>pom.xml</code> file of the module. By default, <code>ArtifactId</code> equals the module name.</p>
Version	<p>Specify <code>Version</code> of the new module, which will be added to the <code>pom.xml</code> file of the module. If a parent Maven project is specified, this coordinate can be inherited from the parent. To do that, select the Inherit check box.</p>
