

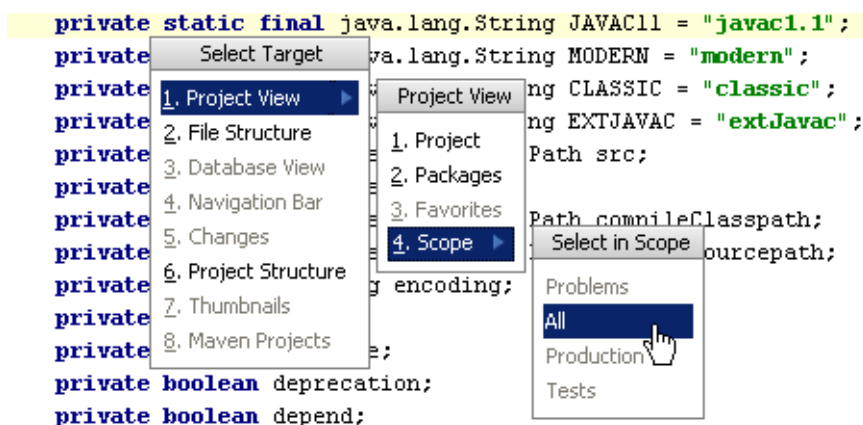
## Navigating Between IDE Components

Suppose you have selected a file or member in the one of the tool windows, and would like to quickly find it in the Project view. The **Select Target** pop-up menu moves the focus to the selected component of IntelliJ IDEA, or to the file system:

- [Navigation Bar](#)
- [Changes tool window](#)
- [Version Control tool window](#)
- [Project Structure](#)
- [Maven tool window](#)
- [Show in Explorer](#)

### To navigate to the desired component

1. Press **Alt+F1** to show the **Select Target** pop-up menu.
2. Use arrow keys or the mouse pointer to select the desired component. If your target is the **Project tool window**, you can select the desired view: Project, Scopes, etc.



Double-click selected file or member in one of the tool windows, or press **Enter** to open it in the editor.
