

Opening a GWT Application in the Browser

You can specify whether you need the [application opened in the browser](#) or not. Moreover, you can choose a browser to use. This can be the default IntelliJ IDEA browser or any other browser of your choice.

To enable or disable opening a GWT application in the browser

1. [Create a GWT run configuration](#).
2. Specify whether you want to the application shown in a browser. Do one of the following:
 - To have a browser launched and display the application, select the **Open in browser** check box. Specify the browser to launch and the starting page of the application.
 - To suppress showing the application in the browser, clear the **Open in browser** check box.

Even if you decide to run the application in the embedded [GWT development mode](#) without launching the browser, you can still specify the `.html` file to start the application from.

To configure the way to show a GWT application

1. Specify the browser to open the application in.
 - To use the default IntelliJ IDEA browser, choose the **Default** item from the drop-down list.
 - To use another configured browser, select the desired browser from the list.
2. To specify the starting page of the application, select the `.html` file that implements this page from the drop-down list.
