


Resource Environment References

Web Tool Window | Context Menu of a Web module | Jump To Source | Assembly Descriptor References

In this pane, define the `<resource-env-ref>` element that contains a declaration of the Web application's reference to an administered object associated with a resource in the Web application's environment.

Based on the settings you specify in this pane, IntelliJ IDEA generates the properties of the `<resource-env-ref>` element in the `web.xml` descriptor.

Item	Property generated in <code>web.xml</code>	Description
Resource Environment References	<code><resource-env-ref-name></code>	In this field, specify the reference name that contains the EJB reference name used in the code of the Web application.
		Click this button to open the Edit Resource Environment Reference dialog box.
Type	<code><resource-env-ref-type></code>	In this field, specify the fully qualified name of the Java language class or interface that implements the type of the resource environment reference.
Description	<code><description></code>	In this field, provide a description of the reference.
