

Saving Project as Template

You can save any existing project as a *user-defined template*.


Once created, such template can be used for creating new projects. When not needed, it can be deleted.

To create a project template

1. Open the desired project in IntelliJ IDEA.
2. On the main menu, choose **Tools | Save Project as Template**.
3. In the dialog box that opens, specify the following:
 - Entire project or a module to be used as the basis for the new project template.
 - Name of the template.
 - Optional description.

IntelliJ IDEA saves the template, and makes this template available under the **User-defined** node of the [New Project](#) wizard.

To delete a project template

1. On the main menu, choose **Tools | Manage Project Templates**. The dialog box displays the list of all available project templates.
2. Select the template you want to delete, and click , or press **Alt+Delete**.

The template is deleted, and no longer available in the [New Project](#) wizard.
