Before you start Drupal development in IntelliJ IDEA:

1. Download and install [Drupal](#).
2. Make sure the *Drupal* plugin is enabled. The plugin is bundled with IntelliJ IDEA and activated by default. If not, enable it as described in [Enabling and Disabling Plugins](#).
