

## Viewing Images

---

IntelliJ IDEA suggests several ways to view images, embedded in the HTML files. You can use [navigation to source](#), [open an image in an external graphical editor](#), or [preview images on-the-fly](#). The viewing modes are configurable in the [Images dialog](#).

### To view an image in IntelliJ IDEA

1. In the Project tool window, select the desired image file.
2. On the context menu of the file, choose **Jump to Source**, or press F4.

Configure the path to the desired external editor in the External Editor section of the [Images dialog](#).

### To view an image in an external editor

1. In the Project tool window, select an image file.
2. On the context menu of the file, choose **Open in external editor**, or press Ctrl+Alt+F4.

To preview an image, place the caret at a reference to an image in the editor, and do one of the following

- On the context menu, choose **Jump to Source**.
- Invoke the [Navigate to declaration](#) feature by pressing Ctrl+B, Ctrl+Button1 Click or Button2 Click.
