Use this pane to map filters to URLs or servlets. Based on the settings you specify, the properties of the `<filter-mapping>` element are generated in `web.xml`.

Before adding a filter mapping, configure a filter in the [General tab](#).

Item	Property generated in <code>web.xml</code>	Description
Filter	<code>&lt;filter-name&gt;</code>	In this drop-down list, select the filter to which you are mapping a URL pattern or a servlet.
URL Pattern	<code>&lt;url-pattern&gt;</code>	Specify the URL pattern that will be used to resolve URL addresses.
Servlet	<code>&lt;servlet-name&gt;</code>	Specify the servlet to map the filter to.
	Add	Click this button to add a new filter mapping.
	Remove	Click this button to remove the selected filter mapping.
	Help F1	Click this button to view the context help page.
