The **Web** tool window presents the project structure as a tree where only modules with **Web facets** are shown. Below each module node, the corresponding `web.xml` deployment descriptor is shown.

Use this tool window to to:

- Find out which modules have Web facets.
- [Configure elements](#) in Web applications: servlets, filters, and listeners.

Context menu

Item	Description
Jump to Source (F4)	Select this option: <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ To open the selected file in the editor. (To open a file in the editor, you can, alternatively, double-click the file.)■ To jump to the selected folder in the Project tool window.
New	Select this option to create a Web application element . Choose the element type in the submenu. The available options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Servlet■ Filter■ Listener
